

State of the Union speech is the President's goals, master plan, and <u>action</u> <u>agenda of programs (steps or "laundry list")</u> for the coming year. It also recaps his past year's accomplishments and any disappointments.


The Budget is the implementation plan, costs, and timeline whereby the steps of the plan can be put into action and with sources of financing for the programs described in SotU. The 2015 budget has already been passed by Congress before Christmas and signed into law.

Typically within a few months after SotU, the President again returns to Capitol Hill to present his **budget**, which is the payment plan for the actions he has outlined in SotU.

Together these two actions are the most powerful tools he has to lead and to achieve his goals for the country.

"Bully Pulpit" is his speaking ability to persuade Congress and the people to support his ideas and his action plan.

State of the Union speech is mandated by the US Constitution and now occurs annually in January or February. Similarly, all other government leaders present a "conditions report" of their institution. Thus, the Governor delivers 'State of the State'; the Mayor 'State of the City'; county judge 'State of the County'; the school superintendent 'State of the Schools', etc.



Joint Session of Congress 9 groups in the audience at SotU include:

- House of Representatives, 435 members, elected by the people, from single member districts (everyone's neighborhood from across the country).
- **100 members of the Senate** (2 from each state)
- 9 Justices of the Supreme Court (appointed by the President for life)
- 15+ Cabinet members (advisors chosen by the President and confirmed by the Senate)
- 5 star Military Generals, commanding officers from each branch of service (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, & Coast Guard)
- Consular Core (Dignitaries of foreign governments with offices in DC & other major US cities, including Houston.)
- First Lady's Special Guests (in the balcony)

Since these are the highest level government officials assembled in one location, one Cabinet member must be secluded elsewhere to honor the Rule of Secession in case there is a disaster requiring them to assume the Office of the Presidency.



The Chamber was flooded with intense light from above, so to maximize the use of high definition cameras located in the balcony which shot across the Chamber to capture the detail of everyone's faces. The intense light created an aura shining on their heads and making their faces glow. Quality of the broadcast was amazingly high.



The intense light created an aura from above and illuminated everything, so to capture the details of the Chamber, people, and everyone's faces. Women wear bright clothes to stand out in the crowd.

Podium and Gallery of the US House of Representatives, the only chamber large enough to hold 600+ government officials. Typically members sit divided by Party, but there is a proposal to show bipartisanship by mixing the seating for themselves.



Many of the Congressmen arrived early to get a prized seat on the aisle to greet the dignitaries as they entered, and most wore bright colors to be easily seen by their constituents at home. Local Houston Congressmen were obvious throughout the broadcast and arrived early to get prize seats on the aisles so to be easily seen on camera.



Cable media provide valuable commentary through the broadcast to explain historical details and introduce the most powerful government officials.





2 US Senators are elected from each state regardless of state size. Texas Senators are elected at-large or by voters statewide; there are no single member districts.

An open seat in 2012 brought forth LT. Gov. Dewhurst and businessman Ted Cruz, Tea Party. This resulted in a brutal Republican Primary, and July Runoff where Tea Party Cruz defeated a longstanding, proven conservative.

So what are ETHICS?

ETHICS is a branch of philosophy that involves recommending <u>concepts of right and wrong conduct</u>, often addressing disputes of moral diversity. The Secretary of Homeland Security has not been put into the line of succession. Senate Bill 442, approved by the Senate in July of 2005, would place the Secretary of Homeland Security eighth in the line of succession, after the Attorney General, if it becomes law. A similar House bill, House Resolution 1455, is currently pending before the House Judiciary Committee.

High level officers of the government (and large corporations) always travel on separate planes to protect the order of succession in case of death of a leader eligible to become President or CEO.



'Designated survivor': Secretary of Energy Ernest Moniz was chosen to watch Obama's speech from an undisclosed location in 2014, to guarantee the continuity of government if the rest of America's leading officials were attacked and killed when they gathered in a single place.

Typically the First Lady chooses guests who have demonstrated acts of heroism over the last year to sit with her in the balcony. Details:

The Opposing Party Response to SotU:




The reality of <u>divided</u> government and the mounting degree of extreme <u>partisan</u> divide became especially apparent through the increased level of disrespect shown towards the President.

During a 2009 joint session, South Carolina Tea Party Congressman Joe Wilson disrupted the entire speech by shouting out "you lie" when Obama mentioned healthcare.

This outburst is

unprecedented in American history. Wilson was rebuked by the House Speaker and he later apologized, but resentment towards the President has continued to grow amongst his critics, both publically and underground.



Outcome of the 2014 election was a Republican landslide that allows them to hold their control of the US House; and also to win the US Senate. Thus, the concept of "divided government" is now redefined to mean the split in philosophical beliefs between Democratic beliefs of President Obama in the White House and the Republican Congress.

Senator Marco Rubio



Rubio, elected to the US Senate in 2010, is one of the Republican Party's rising stars and widely considered to be one of the top contenders for the GOP presidential nomination in 2016. He is also the GOP's most prominent Hispanic American and a member of the Senate group crafting a bipartisan immigration proposal offering a pathway to citizenship for millions of illegal immigrants. Rubio is of Cuban heritage, but was born in Canada and now live in Florida.

Tea Party Response

Tea Party is a fringe branch of Republicans who hold extreme views on reducing the debt and are unwilling to compromise.

Previous years brought forth other rising young or distinguished Republicans to enhance their national visibility and launch their careers on the national stage. Some like Paul Ryan (2012 VP nominee) have succeeded and others like Bobby Jindal bombed.



Indiana Gov. Mitch Daniels gave the Republican response in 2012.



Wisconsin Rep. Paul Ryan delivered the GOP response in 2011 and later became VP nominee.



Louisiana Gov. Bobby Jindal (born in India) self destructed in 2009. Both Democrats and Republicans alike panned Jindal's rebuttal in terms that were decidedly harsh: "amateurish," "laughable" and, most commonly, "a missed opportunity."

In 2010, the SotU Response emphasized "family values" and was given by Bob McDonnell, Governor of Virginia. However, in January 2014, he & his wife were indicted in multiple counts of corruption and wrongdoing.

2014 Republican Response to SotU


Can Cathy McMorris Rodgers resurrect compassionate conservatism?

Republicans typically believe in personal responsibility, independent motivation, competition with others (*capitalism*, survival of the fittest, etc.), "keeping what you earn", and with *minimal involvement of government or its programs*. Their focus is *smaller government*; *especially lower taxes* that can result because funding for these programs can now be eliminated.

Compassionate conservatism is a philosophy that originated after 1979 (Reagan Administration), but was fiercely promoted during the W. Bush period, 2001-2008. It sees social problems such as poverty, lack of education, health care, or immigration as issues that are better solved through cooperation with private companies, charities and religious institutions rather than directly through government departments. It is the theory that the government should encourage the effective provision of social services without providing the service itself."

B. Clinton described it as: "I want to help you. I really do. But you know, I just can't" or similar variants of this *ideology*. Others believe "the only difference between compassionate conservatism and conservatism is that under compassionate conservatism they tell you they are NOT going to help you, *but they are really sorry about it.*"

Why We Form and Express Political Opinions.



Political Ideology

An ideology is a set of beliefs, aims and ideas, especially in politics. An ideology can be thought of as a comprehensive vision, as a way of looking at things, as in common sense or philosophical tendencies. It is a set of ideas proposed by the dominant class of a society whose main purpose is to offer change in society through a normative or abstract thought process. Ideologies are systems applied to public matters and thus make this concept central to politics.

"Political Ideology"

- An individual's ideas, values, and beliefs about the issues, problems, purpose, and scope of government.
- □ Thus these ideas prompt citizens to support a certain political party, policy programs (solutions), and influence the government in the decision-making process.
 - 35% say they are moderate,
 - 30% say they are conservative, and
 - 29% say they are liberal.





Never before has the US had such <u>divided government</u> and as a result, there is deliberate resentment to compromise which is essential in reaching a mutual decision on everything!











Passage of legislation is deliberately difficult so to insure that only important items are included and that there is agreement by all parties. Compromise occurs on the language of a bill as it is modified in committee and shifted between both Chambers for agreement; similar to ping pong. Ultimately a final version is agreed, passed, and sent to the President/Governor for signature into law.



Because of the tough choices presented by the economy and their differing philosophies, leaders have neglected to compromise or make difficult financial decisions, esp. spending cuts to balance the budget. This leaves us with the current situation of doing nothing, aka "kick the can down the road" which delays making a decision until later. **Procrastination** is never a solution or a good method!



Compromise is the key to solutions for complicated problems, especially when each of us has different goals or interprets things differently.

Unfortunately divided government prevents compromise from taking place.

If Congress continues to be uncooperative, the President has the option to use "executive orders", which are declarations signed into law using his presidential powers that circumvent the democratic process of approval by Congress. This is not typical, and not desirable because it is not the will of the people, but when there is no willingness to compromise, he has this option.




'America does not stand still, and neither do I'.

This power is vested in the President <u>by the Constitution</u>, so for him to use it, is NOT abusive or wrong, as is now being portrayed by Republicans and cartoonists. It is a last resort, but it is a fair and just procedure.

These "orders" are not permanent laws however, and they can be undone by the next president. Although almost any law can be "undone" or repealed by the Supreme Court or Congress, it is not likely.

Stockman walked out because he believes Obama will abuse this privilege, but this chart (FACTS) shows there is no evidence of that.


Policy Making Through <u>Regulation</u> or LAWS

■ Executive Orders:

- A rule or regulation issued by the president that has the effect of law, without requiring approval of any other legislative body. They are usually implemented to save time.
 - Presidents typically make them as they leave or enter office to make immediate changes in the ways things are done.
 - ☐ Truman ordered an **end to racial segregation in the military** via an executive order.
 - ☐ **Affirmative action** was institutionalized as national policy through Executive Order 11246 by L.B.J. in 1966
 - Executive orders
 - 2001 Ban on stem cell research using federal funds by G.W. Bush
 - 2009 Lifting the ban on stem cell research by Obama because the science had changed

Executive orders are typically <u>not used</u> (especially on controversial subjects) because they do NOT employ the democratic law-making process <u>of the people</u> via the Congress (i.e. utilizing the people's representatives "one man, one vote"), to achieve agreement / consensus on enacting the law. Laws should be made through group decisions and <u>"the majority rules"</u>, not through any individual power (dictatorship).

June 2012, Obama uses an <u>executive order</u> to lift deportation threats to students, aka *The Dreamers*, thereby allowing them employment opportunities. However, <u>executive orders are not permanent</u> and can be rescinded by future presidents.







March 2010 brought passage of his **HEALTHCARE BILL** by the Congress, much to the resentment of Republicans. 

Tax cuts must also be extended again by March by the Congress, else the middle class will again incur a increase.


