A student is eligible for the degree requirements (including the academic core curriculum) of the catalog of the student's first enrollment. A student may upgrade to a newer catalog year (including the academic core curriculum) if he/she so wishes. However, as long as the student is enrolled at HCC at least once per academic year, he/she is not obligated to meet the requirements of a later catalog.

These principles apply toward transitioning to the new HCC academic core curriculum. New students will start with the new core curriculum this fall. Returning students may remain under the former core requirements or may upgrade to the new core curriculum, if desired. As always, though, the core for core law remains in effect for transfer students. Completion of a core component at any Texas public higher education institution will apply in total and substitute in lieu of the receiving institution's own core requirements.
