

# Alief Arts Art Department Visions by Stanley Kaminski

#### studio classrooms 30' x 37'

- high ceilings: 14" or higher
- large windows facing north
- 1 blackboard 4' tall x 10' wide
- At least 1 large sink (slide included later)
- 8' tall pin board attached to all walls
- Large industrial sink (slide included later)
- 2' x 7' built-in counter space
- 7 built-in cabinets around, below and above the sink (dimensions 1' x 1' x 2' each cabinet)
- Flat built-in storage shelves (dimensions: height 7' x depth 3' x width 10') six shelves 1' high (slide included later)

We need utility sinks with high faucets and ample room for three people to use at once. This is what students in our program need.

- 100 running feet of wall space
- 14' ceilings

- 18 sculpture pedestals
