

## **ARTS 2333 Printmaking I Course Learning Objectives**

Upon successful completion of this course, students will:

1. Identify, define and understand the formal elements of art and the principles of design.
  - a. Create projects that successfully combine the elements and principles of design
  - b. Demonstrate understanding of the elements and principles through in-class and written critiques of artworks
2. Demonstrate the ability to produce and present finished works of exhibition quality.
  - a. Present a finished work for exhibition in the semesterly Student Exhibition
  - b. Prepare exhibition labels, mounts and/or frames as necessary
3. Produce and critique projects that coordinate descriptive and expressive possibilities of course media.
  - a. Demonstrate knowledge of the history of course media through the production of original artworks
4. Select and verify course media and techniques in completed projects.
  - a. Appropriately execute required processes and techniques, as needed, to complete course assignments
