

## **ARTS 2389 Academic Cooperative Course Learning Objectives**

Upon successful completion of this course, students will:

1. Gain practical work experience directly related to the field of art and design.
  - a. Create a thorough self-evaluation through the assessment of at least 3 measurable, personal goals.
  - b. Submit an employer/supervisor evaluation of work completed.
2. Develop a professional résumé, cover letter, and portfolio of artworks, as necessary.

  - b. Assume personal responsibility for required aspects of the project.
